Objectives

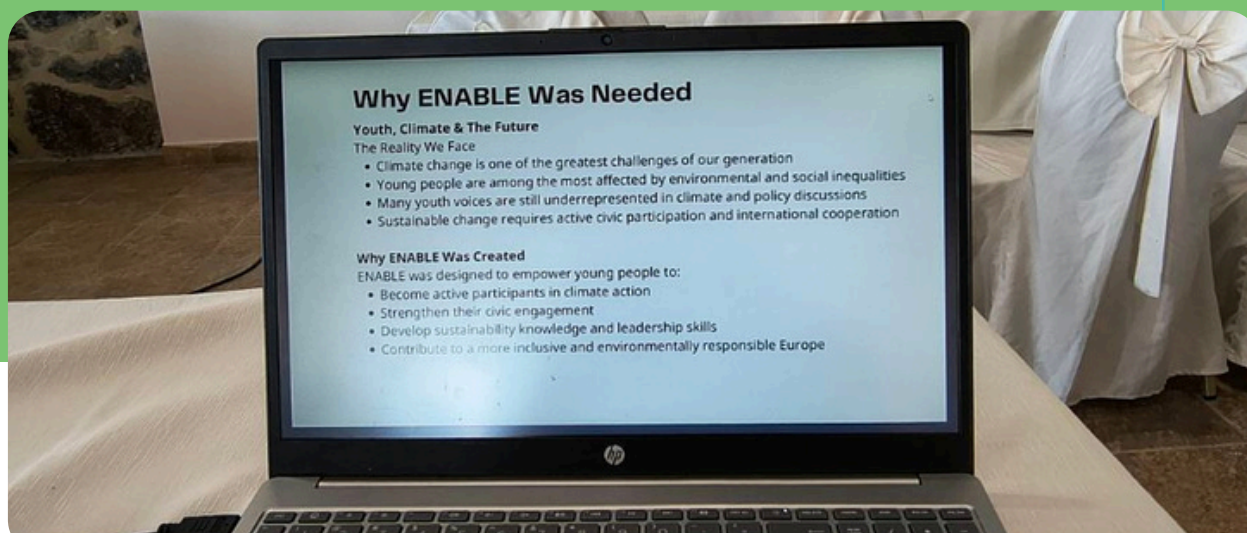
- **Enhance** youth participation in climate governance

The ENABLE Project recently held its Project Closing Event in Kastoria, Greece, bringing together participants and partners dedicated to environmental sustainability, youth participation, and civic engagement.

Taking place from 20–22 May 2026, the event provided an interactive space for participants to reflect on the project's achievements, discuss the Sustainable Development Goals, and exchange ideas for future local initiatives and community action. The programme included presentations of project outcomes, interactive SDG discussions, and roundtable sessions focused on sustainability and active citizenship.

Hosted in the beautiful city of Kastoria, the event also encouraged cultural exchange and stronger cooperation among European partners, inspiring participants to continue promoting positive environmental and social change within their communities.



Day 1 – Project Outcomes, SDGs & Future Action

The main day of the ENABLE Project Closing Event in Kastoria brought together participants, partners, and young people in a collaborative environment focused on sustainability, civic engagement, and future action. The programme began with registration, welcome coffee, and opening remarks introducing the thematic pillars and objectives of the project. Participants were then presented with the key achievements and outcomes of the ENABLE Project, reflecting on its overall journey and impact across participating countries.

An important part of the event was dedicated to interactive dialogue among participants, allowing young people to openly exchange experiences, ideas, and perspectives on environmental sustainability, active citizenship, and the Sustainable Development Goals. Through group discussions and roundtable activities, participants reflected on how the project addressed SDGs in practice and explored ways to remain engaged in climate action and community initiatives after the project's completion. These discussions created a supportive space for intercultural learning, cooperation, and the sharing of good practices between participants from different backgrounds.

The programme also encouraged participants to think about future opportunities for local initiatives, youth participation, and European cooperation, while strengthening their understanding of social responsibility and civic involvement. The day concluded with final reflections, certificate distribution, and a social dinner featuring traditional Greek cuisine, giving participants the opportunity to continue informal discussions and celebrate the successful completion of the ENABLE Project together.
